Keeping you updated

We wanted to provide you with an update on the development and what you can expect from us over the coming months.

Orchard Grove in Comeytrowe

The development is being built in joint venture partnership with LiveWest, as part of a consortium.

Once complete, the whole Orchard Grove development will feature 2,000 homes within two neighbourhoods, a primary school, business park, local centre, park and ride service at the northern part of the development (just off the main roundabout), plus 100 acres of open green space that will include play areas, allotments and sports pitches.

Offsite infrastructure works will include two new roundabouts at the north and south of the development.

Managing agent

The managing agent is Remus and the management company is Orchard Grove (Comeytrowe) Management Company Limited.



Site activity





- There will be a number of attenuation basins at Orchard Grove, which are designed to capture any excess surface water and release it to natural watercourses at a controlled rate.
- Footpaths and roads will be topped, and broadband will be connected, as the homes are completed.
- There is a large area of public open space in the centre of the development between Comeytrowe Lane and the school, which will include allotments. Winding paths and cycle routes will allow residents to walk around the development and through the areas of open space.
- There will be a number of small 'pocket parks' dotted throughout the development. The first phase also includes Highfield Park located in the northeast corner of the development consisting of open wildflower meadows, winding paths and seating areas.
- The development requires a pumping station, which will safely transfer foul drainage away from the site.
- The primary school opened this September. The £11.3 million facility is Somerset's first net zero school.



Ecology

- Orchard Grove will feature a well-connected and integrated network of up to 100 acres of green space, including open space, landscaped areas for surface water drainage, informal play areas and allotments.
- A large bat house has been constructed.
- A number of existing hedgerows and trees are being retained and will be protected throughout the development.

Development news

A huge amount of infrastructure work has already taken place at Orchard Grove; thousands of trees and shrubs have been planted, miles of roads have been laid, and a major new junction has been created to connect the new development to the A38 and Taunton.

The Park and Ride facility is well underway and will provide future sustainable connectivity to Taunton and Wellington via a new bus corridor. The new primary school (for up to 420 pupils) is now open and works have commenced around the local square and employment area, which will include a care and retirement home.
